Annual Military Equipment Report

Pursuant to California Government Code §7070(d)(6), and in accordance with California Government Code §7072, the Central Marin Police Authority will submit to the Central Marin Police Authority Police Council an Annual Military Equipment Report and will make that report publicly available on its internet website. The Annual Military Equipment Report will include the following information for the immediately preceding calendar year for each type of military equipment:

1. A summary of how the military equipment was used and the purpose of its use.
2. A summary of any complaints or concerns received concerning the military equipment.
3. The results of any internal audits, any information about violations of the military equipment use policy, and any actions taken in response.
4. The total annual cost for each type of military equipment, including acquisition, personnel, training, transportation, maintenance, storage, upgrade, and other ongoing costs, and from what source funds will be provided for the military equipment in the calendar year following submission of the annual military equipment report.
5. The quantity possessed for each type of military equipment.
6. If the law enforcement agency intends to acquire additional military equipment in the next year, the quantity sought for each type of military equipment.

The Central Marin Police Authority Police Council will use the Annual Military Equipment Report as a mechanism to ensure the Central Marin Police Authority’s compliance with this Military Equipment Use Policy, and to help it determine whether to approve, revise, or revoke components of the Military Equipment Use Policy for the subsequent year.

Equipment Type: Armored Vehicle – CA Gov’t Code §7070(c)(2)
Use Summary: The armored vehicle was not deployed during 2023. The critical response unit utilized the armored vehicle for training purposes during its regular monthly trainings.
Complaints Received: No complaints were received.
Audits/Use Violations: No violations of use policy were noted.
Annual Cost: \$0

Equipment Type: Command and Control Vehicle - CA Gov’t Code §7070(c)(10)
Use Summary: The incident command trailer was not deployed during 2023. The critical response unit utilized the incident command trailer for training purposes during its regular monthly trainings.
Complaints Received: No complaints were received.
Audits/Use Violations: No violations of use policy were noted.
Annual Cost: \$100



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Equipment Type: Unmanned, remotely piloted, powered ground vehicle- CA Gov't Code §7070(c)(1)
Use Summary: Case details documented in CMPA case #PA23-01286. On August 16, 2023 at approximately 6pm, CMPA Officers were dispatched to a residence on Skylark Drive in Larkspur, on the report of a suspicious circumstance. The caller reported seeing a note, taped to the front door stating, "DO NOT ENTER, CALL 9-1-1, REPORT SUICIDE, LEAVE IMMEDIATELY". Due to the location of the residence, Officers were not able to look through windows to visually clear any obvious hazards. The on-scene incident commander notified the on-call administrator and received authorization to deploy the unmanned, remotely piloted, powered ground vehicle to enter the residence and visually clear it for any hazards. This decision was made out of an abundance of caution for the safety of the first responders on scene to not unnecessarily put them into an unknown hazardous situation. The vehicle was successfully deployed and located a subject who was eventually taken into protective custody for mental health evaluation.

Equipment Type: Less Lethal Shotguns and Bean Bag Rounds - CA Gov't Code §7070(c)(14)
Use Summary: Less lethal shotguns were not deployed or utilized in 2023 other than for annual qualifications and training of new police officers.
Complaints Received: No complaints were received.
Audits/Use Violations: No violations of use policy were noted.
Annual Cost: \$1200

Equipment Type: 40mm Less Lethal Launchers and Kinetic Energy Munitions - CA Gov't Code §7070(c)(14)
Use Summary: The 40mm less lethal systems were deployed for the purpose of annual training for all police officers. The 40mm less lethal system was deployed for an incident that is outlined below: Case details documented in CMPA case #PA23-01286. Between June 12 th and June 18 th , 2023, CMPA received numerous calls for service regarding an individual acting violently and bizarre throughout various locations in CMPA's jurisdiction. The caller was a family member who related the subject was a habitual drug user and was under the influence of methamphetamine. CMPA's history with this



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subject involved prior weapons violations and various drug offenses. On June 19, 2023, the subject's mother called CMPA to report her son was again under the influence of methamphetamine, threatened to kill her and was demanding to be let into the house. Out of fear, the mother called 9-1-1 for assistance.

CMPA Officers arrived on scene and observed the subject sitting in the driver's seat of a vehicle, attempting to leave. Due to the previous history of weapons violations, and other pertinent safety considerations, a high risk stop was conducted. The subject did not comply with multiple orders to surrender and exit the vehicle. The subject began to make a series of furtive movements towards his waistband, acting as if he was in possession of a firearm. After numerous attempts to de escalate unsuccessfully, the 40mm less lethal was deployed once and the subject immediately complied and surrendered. The subject did not sustain any injury from the projectile.

Audits/Use Violations: No violations of use policy were noted.

Annual Cost: \$2,034

Equipment Type: Flashbang Grenades - CA Gov't Code §7070(c)(11)

Use Summary: Flashbang grenades were not deployed or utilized in 2023 other than for training purposes.

Complaints Received: No complaints were received.

Audits/Use Violations: No violations of use policy were noted.

Annual Cost: \$0

Equipment Type: 5.56mm Semiautomatic Rifles and Ammunition - CA Gov't Code §7070(c)(10)

Use Summary: Patrol rifles were not utilized in 2023 other than for annual qualifications and training of new police officers.

Complaints Received: No complaints were received.

Audits/Use Violations: No violations of use policy were noted.
